- Residents of Virginia, over 18, that are U.S. Citizens and not registered and active in another state are eligible.
- The deadline to register or update your address for the General Election is Oct. 24th.

Voting absentee?

- If you are unable to vote in person, you can have the ballot mailed to you.
- Oct. 24th is the deadline to apply for your mail-in ballot.
